- (c) (1) (A) Any parent, guardian, or other legal custodian who enrolls an out-of-district student in a school district and fraudulently represent the address for the domicile of the student for enrollment purposes is liable for restitution to the school district for an amount equal to the local per pupil expenditure identified by the Tennessee Department of Education for the district in which the student is fraudulently enrolled.
- (B) Any parent, guardian, or other legal custodian who enrolls an out-of-state student in a school district and fraudulently represent the address for the domicile of the student for enrollment purposes is liable for restitution to the school district for an amount equal to the state and local per pupil expenditure identified by the Tennessee Department of Education for the district in which the student is fraudulently enrolled.
- 2) (A) Restitution shall be cumulative for each year the child has been fraudulently enrolled in the system. Such restitution shall be payable to the school district and, when litigation is necessary to recover restitution, the parent, guardian, or other legal custodian shall be liable for costs and fees, including reasonable attorneys' fees, incurred by the school district.
